The *Maison Française de Cleveland* announces its Annual French *Concours* for College Students:

Date: **Friday, March 22, 2019**

Place: **John Carroll University - Room 101 - O'Malley Center**

Time: **2:00 PM**

Parking: **Free, stop at Guardhouse, request Visitor's Permit**

The contest consists of two parts: **1) written and 2) oral**

1) **A 500-700 word ESSAY** "*en français*"; hand written, no notes, electronic devices, or dictionaries permitted; a topic chosen from several suggested: Time Limit: 90 minutes; during the essay writing period, candidates will meet one by one with the judges for their oral interview.

2) **A ten minute ORAL EXAMINATION**: a completely impromptu conversation initiated by one of the judges to determine the contestant's ability to handle French in an unanticipated situation.

Each winner of a prize and the professor who recommended the winner are expected to attend the awards banquet as invited guests of the *Maison Française*. It is suggested that participants anticipate the possibility of being winners and keep the date of the awards open.

Additionally, our April event will be a special treat: the brunch will be followed by presentations "*en français*." Every year our brunch guests and members are delighted to see so many talented young people exhibit their love for French and Francophone language and culture. As such, we are delighted to feature the "*lauréats*" themselves as the performers. So, again this year, the program committee will invite and feature our *Concours "lauréats"* to be the presenters. After we have distributed the prizes, we would like to ask each instructor to introduce his or her contest winner, after which the student is invited to talk about him or herself and any additional topic of his or her choice. We are thinking of only a very short impromptu presentation, of 3-4- or perhaps 5 minutes at the most. We are sure that our guests will be charmed! All this, plus the chance to cheer for our high school and college winners of our annual *Concours*!

Please encourage your best students to participate. Have them fill out the registration form (please make extra copies if needed), and verify the information before you sign the form.
